GROUND CLEARING SCHEDULED FOR FAIRFAX COUNTY PARKWAY - PHASE III

Activities scheduled for Rolling and Hooes Roads realignment

STARTING WEEK OF NOVEMBER 8th, 2010
WEATHER PERMITTING

Starting the week of November 8th, crews will begin clearing trees and brush along the Fairfax County Parkway in Springfield for utility relocations and upcoming work on Phase III of the Fairfax County Parkway Project. Phase III includes the realignment of Rolling and Hooes Roads and reconfiguration of the Franconia-Springfield Parkway interchange.

This clearing will occur Monday through Friday, 7 a.m. - 5 p.m., and continue until late fall or early winter. Areas that will be affected include:

- both sides of Rolling Road south of the Community of Faith Tabernacle Baptist Church
- east side of the parkway south of Hooes Road
- relocated ramp to Hooes Road to and from the Franconia-Springfield Parkway
- between Barkers Court and the Fairfax County Parkway on the relocated Rolling Road route
